Following negotiations with UKATA, the NICEIC have recognised the requirement to emphasise, update and refresh its' members on the risk posed from exposure to asbestos and as such, have developed a working Partnership with UKATA and its' members.

The NICEIC have some 25,000 company members covering the whole of the UK and are one of the major trade groups identified as being at risk by the current HSE campaign, 'The Hidden Killer'.

Asbestos has been identified as the biggest work related killer in recent times, the Hidden Killer campaign identifies that Electricians, Plumbers, Joiners and the general building trades are now the most at risk.
