DEFINITIONS

In these terms and conditions, unless the context otherwise requires:

CPD means Continued Professional Development for all registered Tutors;

Member means an organisation, company, individual who has satisfied the criteria of membership;

Rules means these Rules of the Membership which govern membership;

Site means the website, www.accounts.ukata.org.uk;

Terms means the Terms and Conditions;

Terms and Conditions mean the Terms and Conditions that detail the rules that apply to the access and use of the Tutor Registration System;

Tutor means an individual engaged or employed by a Member to deliver Approved Training;

Tutor Knowledge Test means an exam required to be undertaken and successfully passed by all registered Tutors at the relevant category of training they will deliver on behalf of the Member;

Tutor Registration System means the online software owned by UKATA which Members must use to register Tutors and undertake the Tutor Knowledge Test and maintain CPD.

INTRODUCTION

- 1. This is a contract with the UK Asbestos Training Association Ltd, whose registered office is at Markham Vale Environment Centre, Markham Lane, Markham Vale, Chesterfield, Derbyshire, S44 5HY, henceforth referred to as "UKATA".
- 2. Please carefully read the following Terms before accessing the Tutor Registration System Site. By accessing the Site (which includes, visiting, registering, or accessing the Tutor Knowledge Test and CPD programme) you accept and agree to the covenants and conditions imposed in this agreement. If you do not agree to these Terms, you may not access the Site.
- 3. By using this service, you agree that you have read, understood and agree to these Terms. You also agree to review this agreement periodically to be aware of modifications to the agreement, which UKATA may make at any time. Your continued use of this Site will be deemed your conclusive acceptance of any modified agreement.

FINANCIAL

- 9. UKATA quotes prices and issues invoices in UK pounds (GBP) only. The Member must pay in the currency shown on the invoice.
- 10. UKATA reserve the right to review the pricing and take appropriate action when changes to the system or exam specification occur beyond our control.
- 11. Tutors who fail to complete the Tutor Knowledge Test will not be eligible for a refund.

TUTOR REGISTRATION SYSTEM MATERIALS

12. All material relating to the Tutor Registration System is the property of UKATA.

- 13. This training material has been prepared, maintained, updated and distributed by UKATA.

ACCESS TO THE TUTOR REGISTRATION SYSTEM

To that end, UKATA will take all commercially reasonable efforts to provide uninterrupted access of the Tutor Registration System to its registered users. However, from time to time, registered users may be unable to access the Tutor Registration System due to conditions beyond UKATA's control. Such conditions include, but are not limited to: force majeure, acts of God, power outages, and the acts of computer hackers and others acting outside the law. Also, from time to time, access may be unavailable due to software issues, server downtime, increased internet traffic or downtime, programming errors, regular maintenance of the system and other related reasons. To that end, UKATA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to change, modify, or discontinue any aspect or feature of this site in whole or in part, including, without limitation, the content, availability, access and/or the terms of this site. Such changes, modifications, additions or deletions will be effective immediately upon notice thereof, which notice may be made by posting such changes on this site.

21. Registered users are solely responsible for ensuring that they have sufficient and compatible hardware, software, telecommunications equipment and internet service necessary for use of the site.

SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 22. UKATA will only issue a UKATA certificate of knowledge on behalf of a Tutor who has satisfactorily completed a Tutor Knowledge Test with a pass mark of 80% or more.
- 23. The certification will only be valid for a period of up to three years.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- 24. All cancellations must be received in writing.
- 25. If a Tutor cannot access the Tutor Registration System online via www.accounts.ukata.org.uk because they fail to meet the required system requirements given on the website, then UKATA will not take responsibility or give a refund to the Member.
